Skater Incentive Program

July 1, 2009 – June 30, 2010

The skater competition incentive program is designed to reward Birmingham FSC (BFSC) primary skating members for participation in USFS sanctioned competitions and BFSC events. The following formula awards points to skaters based on the various competitions and functions in which BFSC skaters participate.

The basic formula accumulates all points earned by BFSC skaters (the Skater Point Total). The total funds available are divided by the total of all skater points. This gives a dollar Value to each point. Each skater will receive a subsidy equal to their individual Skater Point Total multiplied by the dollar Value for 2009-2010.

Key Points:

1. No single skater or team shall receive a reward greater than one-fifth of the total funds allocated for each competition season.
2. Points shall be calculated for all eligible BFSC skaters annually (July 1 – June 30). An eligible skater is any BFSC skater who is a primary member of the club in good standing on July 31 of the year during which the rewards are accumulated (Note – this was extended to August 7, 2009 for the 2009-2010 year only).
3. Skaters should complete the Incentive Program Form at the end of the membership year. Results sheets must be attached for at least one event from each competition.
4. Skaters will receive one additional point for advancing from an initial to a final round of any qualifying competition.
5. A minimum of 5 volunteer hours with the BFSC by the skater and/or the skater's family members is required to receive these funds. Volunteer time sheets must be turned in with the Incentive Program Form, but should be filled out and signed at the time the volunteer activity is completed.
6. Skaters must attend at least 50% of BFSC functions (i.e. Club nights, the Annual Awards Banquet, and the Annual General Membership Meeting). Skaters (or their families) are responsible for obtaining attendance confirmation at each event. These attendance sheets must be turned in with the Incentive Program Form.
7. Skaters that are participating members of the Junior Board of the BFSC will receive 1 additional point.
